## Abstract submission

The Symposium program will be partially composed by submitted abstracts. Abstracts selected will be presented orally (15 minutes for presentation + 5 minutes questions).

## Criteria for abstract submission

- It must be written in Danish or English languages, explained abbreviations may be used.
- Abstracts reporting on studies and projects (development and research) at any stage, study protocols or non-empirical work are welcome
- The abstract text cannot exceed 300 words (incl. headlines and spaces, excl. title, authors and affiliation). References must not be included in the abstract.
- Drugs should be referred to by their generic name.
- The main source of funding of a study should be indicated at the end of the abstract.
- Abstracts should be in word or PDF

## Abstracts should be structured and outline the:

- Background and aims (or goal of work)
- Methods (design, data collection, analysis or approach taken)
- Results or Discussion
- Conclusion (considerations or lessons learned)

## Abstract categories

A theme from the list below that most closely describes the content of the abstract should be included before abstract title. Accepted abstracts may be re-categorized by the scientific committee in order to compose the final program.

- **Theme 1: Cancer and network** (e.g. family, caregivers, relatives, next of kin, children, friends, work relation, peer support, patient associations etc.)
- **Theme 2: Cancer and complementary treatment and care** (e.g. complementary and alternative medicine, integrative oncology, integrative care, supportive care etc.)
- **Theme 3: Cancer and symptom management** (e.g. pain, fatigue, nausea and vomiting, mucositis, neuropathy, appetite, nutrition, non-pharmacological treatment etc.)
- **Other:** (e.g. communication, COVID-19, geriatric population, education, rehabilitation, research methodology and methods etc.)
